Start of cavern construction in the Brünig massif

Brünig Mega Safe AG (BMS) has begun construction of the underground caverns in Lungern. With the conclusion of the first customer contracts, the prerequisites for commencing work in the Brünig massif were fulfilled. The official groundbreaking took place on January 28, 2026. BMS expects the first caverns to be completed in approximately two years.

Brünig Mega Safe AG, headquartered in Lungern, is a privately owned company majority-held by the Gasser siblings (Isabel, Patrick, and Thomas) and comprises three business divisions:

- Sustainable storage facilities in the Brünig mountain massif (Brünig Lagerhallen)
- Premium security facilities and high-security storage solutions within the Swiss mountain massif (MonSec)
- The Swiss Competence Center for Applied Security (Bruenig Institute)

Planning permission for the storage facilities and the high-security area has been in place for about one year. BMS offers tailor-made storage facilities and high-security infrastructures for the most demanding requirements, which can be acquired under building rights arrangements.

Customers define their needs, and BMS AG works with them to develop optimal solutions. Thanks to many years of expertise and already highly developed base infrastructures, the caverns can be realized much more quickly, easily, and comparatively cost-effectively than above-ground facilities. BMS constructs the storage facilities, provides access, installs the infrastructure, and ensures maintenance.

Demand for reliable, fully protected security infrastructures, including protection against drones, has increased significantly in recent months amid the deteriorating international security environment. In particular, BMS has observed growing interest from companies seeking to offer their own customers integrated storage and high-security solutions.

Legal certainty is central: a distinguishing feature of BMS is that its underground security facilities are equipped with publicly secured ownership and operating rights. BMS works closely with an experienced security company. The Bruenig Institute, the third pillar of the company, serves as a training center for security courses and training, risk analysis, and resilience. It has also begun operations in Lungern and is continuously expanding its course offerings.
